The event will take place on Thursday, September 5, 2024, at 7:00 PM at the Redding City Hall (Community Room) in Redding, California.

Residents who were renters or homeowners residing in <u>High or Very High Fire Hazard Severity</u>

<u>Zones</u> during the Shasta County fires of 2018 or 2020 are encouraged to attend. GSFA also encourages all wildfire recovery agencies and organizations, real estate professionals, residential service providers and members of the media to attend this pivotal event. Community participation is vital in supporting the recovery efforts and spreading awareness about the ReCoverCA Homebuyer Assistance Program.

The event promises to be informative and empowering, offering attendees the opportunity to learn more about the program and begin their journey towards homeownership.

About the ReCoverCA Homebuyer Assistance Program

The ReCoverCA Homebuyer Assistance Program provides financial assistance up to \$350,000 per household, designed to help qualifying individuals and families to purchase a home outside of <u>High or Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones</u> of California.

"We are extremely lucky to live where we live, surrounded by an incredible outdoor playground and great people. - But one of the very few negatives is the very real possibility of a sudden onset of wildfires," said Shasta County Supervisor Kevin Crye. "Thankfully we have some of the best firefighters in the world, but sometimes wildfires break through and wreak havoc on our community, decimating entire communities. It is at that point people will need all the help they can get in rebuilding their lives. Having access to programs like the ReCoverCA Homebuyer Assistance Program will prove to be invaluable."

Key highlights include:

- Financial assistance up to \$350,000.
- Forgiveness of financial assistance after five years.
- Accessibility for applicants with varying credit histories.

"We invite all interested individuals to join us at the upcoming event to explore how the program can benefit you or someone else in your community," said Carolyn Sunseri, GSFA Marketing Director. "Imagine owning your own home, free from the worries and insurance costs of living in a high fire zone. This event is the first step towards making that dream a reality."
